


PRINCE2™ for Practitioners Course Outline

PRINCE2 is a project management method that will benefit all types and sizes of projects in any domain. Designed to facilitate effective control of projects, it consists of 3 integrated elements - 7 Principles, 7 Themes, 7 Processes – with supporting advice on governance and tailoring the method to meet organisational and project needs.

The Practitioners course is designed to develop the participant's ability to apply PRINCE2 in different project environments and adapt PRINCE2 to specific project scenarios.

PRINCE2 for Practitioners is delivered as a 5 day event.



Who should attend?

Project Managers in need of a method to help manage projects of different types and sizes and project and programme support staff wanting to learn how to effectively apply PRINCE2 to projects.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites for the course, however candidates for the Practitioner Exam must have passed the Foundation Examination. We do recommend that participants complete 10 - 12 hours of pre-course work. Our pre-course pack will be sent to all participants on payment of the course fee.

The Practitioner training will:

- Expand the participant's understanding of the principles and philosophies underpinning PRINCE2.

- Explain how PRINCE2 can be effectively applied to address the needs and problems of a specific project scenario.
- Prepare participants for PRINCE2 Practitioner Certification

Course Composition

The training is a scenario based training course focusing on the application of PRINCE2 under different project environments and scenarios. Review and revision sessions of all PRINCE2 elements are included throughout the training.

Foundation Exam

The PRINCE2 Foundation Exam is a 1 hour closed book classical multiple choice exam. The participant must answer 75 questions and score 50% or more of the available marks to pass the exam.

Practitioner Exam

The PRINCE2 Practitioner Exam is a 2 ½ hour open book scenario based multiple choice exam. The participant must provide responses to 9 questions presented in the following styles:

- Classical multiple choice
- Matching
- Yes/No
- Sequencing
- Multiple response
- Assertion/Reason

The maximum score for the exam is 108 marks. The participant must score 55% or more marks to pass the exam.

Practitioner Re-registration - PRINCE2 Practitioners are required to be re-registered within 3-5 years of their original certification. This re-registration comprises a 1-hour examination set at the same standard as the Practitioner examination.
